Առաքելութիւն = Ministry

Մեր Տիրոջ ու փրկչին Յիսուս Քրիստոսի երկրաւոր կեանքը ընդհանրապէս կոչուած ու ճանցուած է **առաքելութիւն** բացատրութեամբ, որովհետեւ այդ կեանքը ունէր նպատակ մը եւ այդ նպատակը ուրիշ բան չէր եթէ ոչ Աստուծոյ սէրն ու ողորմութիւնը ցոյց տալ մարդոց, որպէսզի մարդ արարածն ալ իր կարգին Աստուծոյ Մէրն ու ողորմածութիւնը տեսնելով, դառնար դէպի ճշմարիտն ու յաւիտենականը:

Մարդկութեան պատմութեան ընթացքին, Աստուած զանազան մարդոց վստահած է զանազան առաքելութիւններ. օրինակ՝ Աստուած Մովսէս մարգարէին վստահեցաւ Եբրայեցի ժողովուրդին խօստացուած երկիր առաջնորդելու առաքելութիւնը. Դաւիթ Մարգարէին՝ այդ երկրին թագաւորութիւնը շարունակելու ու անոր ապագան մարագարեանալու առաքելութիւնը. եւ այսպէս Աստուած իր ընտրած իւրաքանչիւր անձին վստահեցաւ առաքելութիւն մը եւ այդ առաքելութիւնը ուրիշ բան չէր եթէ ոչ Աստուծոյ ծրագիրները յայտնել եւ Աստուծոյ Մէրն ու ողորմութիւնը բացայայտել: Այսպէս ընելով, Աստուած իր ընտրեալներուն միջոցաւ Ինքզինք ճանաչելի դարձուց մարդկութեան ընդհանրապէս եւ Եբրայեցի ժողովուրդին մասնաւորաբար:

Անոնք իրենց առաքելութեան ետինք նոյնիսք տեսան մահը. սակայն Աստուծոյ աւետարանին տառածման ուրախութիւնը աւելի մեծ էր քան մահուան վախը: Առաքելները շատ լաւ գիտէին թէ նոյնիսկ եթէ մահանային, Աստուած իրենց պիտի յարուցնէր մեռելներէն ինչպէս իր Միածին Որդիին Յիսուս Քրիստոսի յարութիւն տուաւ:

Այսպիսով զԱստուած ճանչնալու եւ ճանչցնելու առաքելութիւնը, սերունդէ սերունդ փոխանձուեցաւ եւ հասաւ մինչեւ մեր օրերը: Այսօր մենք ալ որպէս Քրիստոնէսներ եւ մանաւանդ Հայ Առաքելական եկեղեցւոյ զաւակներ, ունինք մեր առաքելութիւնը. այդ առաքելութիւնը կը բնորոշուի «Միրել զԱստուած ամբողջ սրտով եւ սիրել մեր ընկերը եւ նմանը մեր անձին պէս» զոյգ պատուիրաններուն մէջ: Մենք եկեղեցի յաճախելով եւ Աստուածաշունչի սերտողութիւններ կատարելով, միայն կը սորվինք թէ կեանքի ամբողջ տեւողութեան ինչպէս պիտի կարենանք մեր հարստութիւնը երկինքի մէջ հաւաքել. սակայն՝ երբ մեր սորվածները կեանքի բերենք, այն ժամանակ միայն կը սկսինք մեր հարստութիւնը շահիլ եւ պահել Աստուծոյ մօտ: Այս իսկ պատճառով կարեւոր է եկեղեցւոյ դերը:

How wonderful that Jesus came to earth to save us

Jesus said “I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.” John 10:10

Before the creation of the world God had a plan to save human kind from their sins through the shedding of Jesus’ blood, 1st Peter 1:18-21.

In John 1:29 John the Baptist testifies that Jesus is the perfect lamb that takes away the sins of the world.

Moreover, Jesus said it clearly to Pilate “ For this purpose I was born and for this purpose I have come to the world.....” John 18:37

Hebrews 2:14 explains why Jesus was born in flesh and blood, so He can take all the sins upon Him and pay the wages of our sins on the cross and free us from condemnation. Furthermore, as the Son of God and by God’s power He was resurrected and had victory over death, Acts 2:24. As a result, He gave us eternal life. John 5:11-12 teaches us , “And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.” We must have faith that through Jesus’ death and resurrection, we have eternal life.

Why is the shedding of blood for our sins important ?

God is holy and cannot tolerate sin. Therefore, when Jesus was crucified on the cross carrying all of our sins, God turned His face from His only begotten Son. This momentary separation from God brought all of us together and we have been reconciled with God , Matthew 27:45-46.

Furthermore, Galatians 4:4-5 and Ephesians 1:9-11, teaches us that God waited until the world was ready to receive His Son. When the message of the gospel could be carried to the whole world .

Jesus is the gift of God, “Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift!” 2nd Corinthians 9:15.

In fact, we have been blessed with multiple gifts . To name a few, God’s love for us, John 15:9,13 ; Forgiveness of sins, Ephesians 1:7; The Holy Spirit , John 14:2 ; and ETERNAL LIFE, 1st John 5:12.

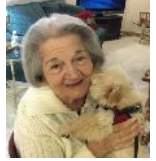
