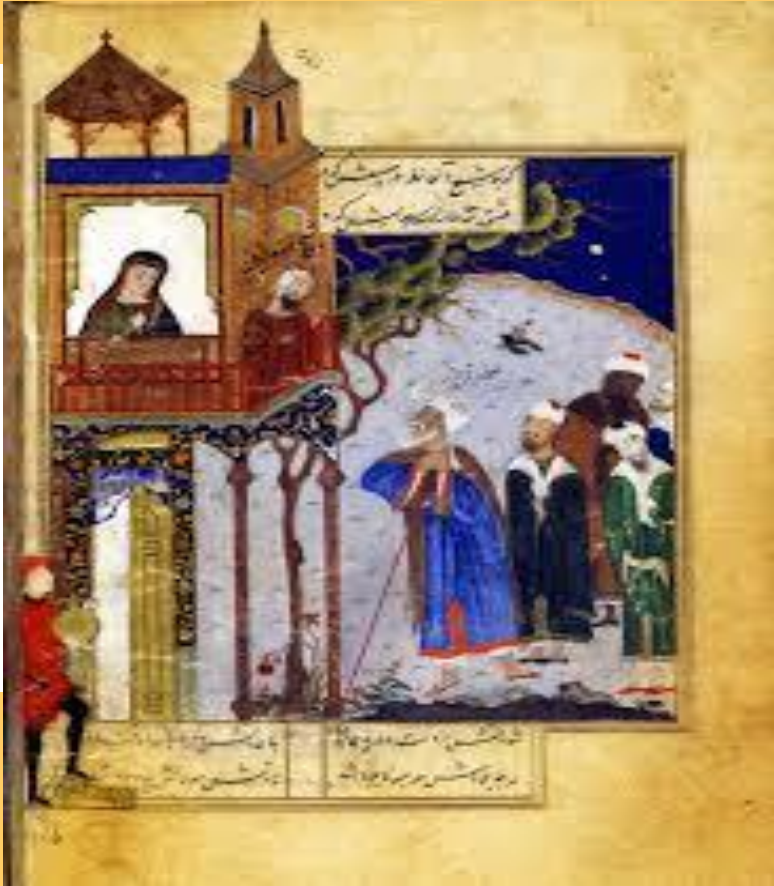

How do you overcome fear?

We all know that when we sin or do something wrong, we are usually ashamed of it; therefore, we don't want to talk about it or we even want to forget it. Nevertheless, the feeling of guilt is there even though we can't bring ourselves to talk about it. Have you ever wondered why this happens? Why is it that when we sin, we feel shame? Is it because we are afraid of the righteousness of God?

We regret when we sin, and after our regret, our fear to confess that sin begins, or even worse, we become afraid to pray to our Lord and ask for forgiveness. This is known as *fear*. While we are busy fearing the righteousness of God, we forget about his love. While we are busy fearing about God's justice, we forget about his mercy. And finally, while we are busy fearing about our punishment, we forget about our salvation. So why is fear a problem when we already have the solution? Why create a problem, while we are already living in the solution?

The Bible shows us that every sinful person, who is chosen by God, never forgets about God's love and mercy. If they do, their lives will be ruined by evil acts because the desire for evil will overpower them and they will stray away from God's path. Instead of remembering about God's love, they feel the need for His mercy and they return to Him as did the Prodigal Son. For he who trusts God's Love never fails, and he who hopes for God's mercy, never loses the opportunity of being God's beloved son, who is delivered by the blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. So by trusting in God's love and mercy, we can pray for our sins, regret the act, and ask the Lord for His mercy so that we are not judged for our acts and that our sinful acts are forgiven by our Lord.

In these days, we also have to pray for our brothers and sisters, for God may open their eyes to see the truth. We have to pray for our parents, for God may heal their pain and sickness. We have to pray for our community, for God to lead them to the right path, and finally we have to pray for our church, for God to send His blessings upon us, and deliver us from the evil.

God's Wings

An article in National Geographic several years ago provided a penetrating picture of God's wings. After a forest fire in Yellowstone National Park, forest rangers began their trek up a mountain to assess the inferno's damage. One ranger found a bird literally petrified in ashes, perched statuesquely on the ground at the base of a tree. Somewhat sickened by the eerie sight, he knocked over the bird with a stick. When he gently struck it, three tiny chicks scurried from under their dead mother's wings. The loving mother, keenly aware of impending disaster, had carried her offspring to the base of the tree and had gathered them under her wings, instinctively knowing that the toxic smoke would rise. She could have flown to safety but refused to abandon her babies. When the blaze had arrived and the heat had scorched her small body, the mother had remained steadfast. Because she had been willing to die, those under the cover of her wings would live.

Message: God never sends you into a situation alone. God goes before you, He stands beside you, He walks behind you. Whatever the situation, be confident God is with you. As we navigate through these stressful times of the COIVD 19 pandemic, remember that God is always there for you. "He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge."

What happens when a person dies ?

When a person dies, his body will be buried and decay, dust to dust, Genesis 3:19. But what happens to a person's spirit ? The word of God says that at the moment of death, the spirit departs the body and consciously goes either to eternal glory in heaven or eternal tournament in Hell; however, the physical body remains in the grave "sleeping." There is no intermediate or holding place as some people think.

The spirit of the believers never dies, because He, the eternal Spirit of God lives in them. In the parable of the rich man and Lazarus, Jesus teaches us and explain clearly what happens after a person dies. Luke 16:19-31. When the rich man died, immediately his spirit went to Hades, which represents the place of torment or Hell. But when Lazarus died Immediately the angels escorted him in spirit to Abraham's bosom, which represents Heaven where the dead who are righteous go.

Obviously, Lazarus must have had a true relationship of faith with God, and the rich man did not. Romans 3:22-24. Both, the rich man and Lazarus were aware of where they were and they recognized each other. However, there was a great chasm or deep cleft in the earth's surface between them so no one can cross over to the other side. This parable is the only parable where Jesus names a person, Lazarus. This name Lazarus, means a man depends on God.

When Jesus was on the cross, the thief who was on His right side, through God's grace, believed that Jesus is the Lord and believed in eternal life. Jesus promised him that immediately after death he would be with Jesus in heaven. "And Jesus said to him, "Assuredly, I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise." Luke 23:43

The apostle Paul in his second letter to Corinthians 5:8 , teaches with confidence that "absent from the body, present with the Lord." The apostle Paul in Philippians 1:21-24 said , "he desires to depart from his body and be with Christ" . Which clearly means that when a true believers dies, he goes to be with Jesus in the presence of God in Heaven.

Hebrews 9:27 says; "And just as each person is destined to die once and after that comes judgment." This means that there are no second chances after death . There is no biblical teaching or support to the idea of a second chance

Apostle Paul comforts the believers that all who died in Christ will come with Jesus at the time of the rapture of the church just before the 7 years of the tribulation. "And now, dear brothers and sisters, we want you to know what will happen to the believers who have died so you will not grieve like people who have no hope. For since we believe that Jesus died and was raised to life again, we also believe that when Jesus returns, God will bring back with him the believers who have died." 1 Thessalonians 4:13-14. Paul continues in verse 15 that it was a direct revelation from Christ "We tell you this directly from the Lord." 1 Thessalonians 4:15

"For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord." Romans 8:38-39

Tribute to Frances L. Tusan of Sanger, California

June 12, 1933 - April 5, 2020

FRANCES TUSAN was born June 12, 1933, the first child of Armen Gougasian, an orphaned genocide survivor, and Gladys Kevorkian. Frances attended elementary school in the rural Central Valley California town of Terra Bella while taking piano and dance lessons. Eventually her family moved to Fresno where she graduated from Roosevelt High School in 1949, just a few days shy of her 17th birthday.

From a young age, Frances wanted to be a Nurse but had to wait until she turned 18 before she could start Nursing school. It was during this time she met Virginia Yeram - now Sarabian – another aspiring nurse, which started a lifelong friendship, really a sisterhood, that has lasted until this day.

While still a teenager and attending Nursing school, she attended dances sponsored by local Armenian organizations while tagging along with her Aunt Florence. It was at one of these dances she met a skinny farmer and saxophone player from Sanger, Bob Tusan and they started dating in 1950. While Bob was immediately ready to marry, Frances' parents wouldn't allow it until she finished her education. On June 27, 1953 Frances and Bob were married at the Holy Trinity Church in Fresno.

They rented a home in Fresno for three years, then purchased the family farm on Jensen Avenue. Frances worked at Fresno Community Hospital, Fowler Hospital, and finally Sanger Hospital until she retired at 70 years old. She loved every minute of nursing, as she would frequently recount vivid stories of the surgery du jour while the family attempted to eat their nightly dinner.

Frances enjoyed hosting holiday gatherings at her home for immediate family, aunts, uncles and cousins. She was a fantastic cook and could effortlessly whip up a sit-down meal for 20 people in no time. She would be the first one up in the morning to prepare breakfasts, and be the last one, and frequently the **ONLY** one cleaning up at the end of a busy day.

Frances was active in the Holy Trinity Church Trinity Guild and Ladies Guild, holding many offices including President for multiple years, as well as serving on the church's Board of Trustees. She was also an active member of the Home Guild at the California Armenian Home where she also held many offices, including President for three terms. She earned the unofficial title of the Kufta Queen of Fresno, after chairing kufta production for both the Church and Armenian Home, making kufta for sale to raise funds for both organizations. She has probably had her hands in the making upwards of 100,000 kuftas over the years.

We will miss Frances tremendously! May God bless her soul!
