Why Does the Church Prefer to Baptize Infants?

One of the most sensitive and delicate issues that an Armenian Apostolic Church priest faces in the 21st Century is baptizing infants, because some people question the act by saying “Why do you baptize infants when they do not understand anything?” or “The parents should not bring their infants to baptism. The children must choose their faith when they start to understand.” These statements could sound very reasonable, but at the same time they are baseless and very untrue, because they do not have any Biblical base. The same people could say that even baptizing infants has no Biblical proof.

As parents, it is an obligation to teach your children about God and truth, about Christianity and love, about humanity and service. Christianity is not only about being a good person in life, but also about acknowledging God as our Father and savior through the Holy Spirit (...). In the Bible there are too many phrases and quotes that teach the parents about their parental obligations, and especially when it comes to faith. For example, in Proverbs 22:6 it says, “Train up a child in the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it” and in 29:15 of the same book, it says, “The rod and reproof give wisdom: but a child left to himself brings his mother to shame.” How obvious it is especially in the second verse, that the parents should not let their child decide about their future, simply because they know nothing about life, so they can be lost when they have no guidance from the parents who are their first teachers.

To show how Biblical the baptism of the infants is, we would like to mention some verses from the Bible itself which, as you know, is the foundation of our sacred faith.

1.- In the book of Genesis, when God talks to Abraham about the circumcision which was a sign of the chosen people of God, and later substituted by the baptism in the New Testament, God said, “...For the generations to come every male among you who is eight days old must be circumcised” (Gen. 17:12). The circumcision was going to be substituted by the baptism because both were signs of being the chosen people or the children of God. Circumcision has made the Jews unique physically, as they fulfilled God's commandment in that way. However, baptism made us unique spiritually, because through baptism we become the children of God, and most importantly we will be able to enter the Kingdom of God (John 3:5)

2.- In the Book of Exodus we read about the Jewish people crossing the Red Sea (Ex. 13:17-14:29), which, according to St. Paul the apostle, symbolizes baptism “For I do not want you to be ignorant of the fact, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud and that they all passed through the sea. They were all baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea” (1Cor.10:1-2). Obviously during that time, when the entire Jewish people were passing through the Red Sea, there were infants.

3.- In the New Testament, in the book of the Acts, there are three narrations of “household baptisms” (Acts 10:24-48, 16:11-15, 16:25-40), St. Paul the Apostle in his first letter to Corinthians says “Yes, I also baptized the household of Stephanas; beyond that, I don’t remember if I baptized anyone else.” It is possible that when these families got baptized, there were no kids or infants within them. However, it was just a usual thing to baptize the infants so they could be committed to the faith from their young ages and learn about it too.

When Jesus Christ was ready for his ministry, He got baptized first, went to the desert to fast for 40 days, and only then went and started His ministry. This incident teaches us that we need the strength, the guidance, and the enlightenment of the Holy Spirit during our life, because without these, as the proverbs mentioned above, it will bring shame on the Christian family, and we receive the Holy Spirit through the baptism. Therefore, we must baptize infants before they grow, learn false things and face the difficulties in life.

If it is about understanding what is going on during the baptism, or what is baptism, the parents could teach their children about it by reading Matthew 3:13-17, Mark 1:9-13 and Luke 3:21-32. It is simply being washed from original sin and being the adopted child of God, redeemed by the blood of Christ, and saved by the grace of the Spirit. We do not understand more than this and that is why we call it a mystery.

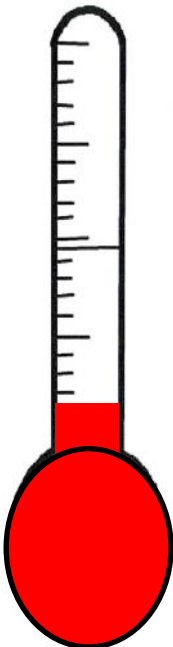
Our church, with its great history and diverse congregation, has always had great love for each other. I pray that as the years go on, we can continue to be there for each other and that we genuinely care for each other.

The Holy Spirit

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Holy Trinity, God the Father, God the Son, and God the Spirit. The Holy Spirit was present in the creation of the world, Genesis 1:1-2,26. In the Old Testament, the Holy Spirit temporarily came upon specific people to empower them to do essential and unusual tasks that God asked. For example: The Holy Spirit gave Bezalel artistic abilities Exodus 31:1-5. Helped Joshua to take Moses' Responsibilities to lead the Israelites to the promised land, Deuteronomy 34:9. Empowered David to rule, 1 Samuel 16:13. Enabled Zechariah to prophesy, 2nd Chronicles 24:20.

In the New Testament, John the Baptist, the greatest among all the prophets, was filled with the Holy Spirit in his mother's womb to prepare for Jesus' coming, Luke 1:15, 7:26-28. John the Baptist is considered a prophet since he was born before Christ, Luke 1.

Jesus breathed on His disciples and spoke to prepare them for what would happen in a short while until His Ascension, John 20:22. The disciples received the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost after Jesus Ascension, Acts 2:1-4, 4:8, 13:9,52.

We receive the Holy Spirit immediately upon our salvation, John 7:38-39, Ephesians 1:12-14. Also, He dwells in us forever, John 14:16-17. Being filled with the Holy Spirit doesn't mean we will not have difficulties, conflicts, hardship, or illnesses, but He will guide us through them all, 1 Corinthians 10:13. Even when we sin, He immediately convicts us, so we confess our sin and receive forgiveness, 1 John 1:9

The Holy Spirit has three essential convicting works in the world and in individual's hearts regarding sin, righteousness, and judgment, John 16:7-11. The only sin that is not forgiving is blasphemy against the Holy Spirit since God offers salvation through the Holy Spirit, Matthew 12:30-32.

The Holy Spirit has a significant role in the believer's lives.

- Gives us spiritual life, John 3:5-8, John 6:63, 2 Corinthians 3:6.
- Seals us and secures our eternal life, 2 Corinthians 1:22, Ephesians 1:13-14.
- Gives us the assurance that we are the children of God and heirs with Christ, Romans 8:14-16
- Enables Godly people to prophecy and preach boldly, Acts 4:31, 2 Peter 1:21.
- Teaches us and reminds us of God's word and gives us peace, John 14:26-27, John 16:12-16.
- Testifies of Christ in us, John 15:26-27.
- Empowers us, Acts 1: 8.
- Comforts and encourages us, acts 9:31.

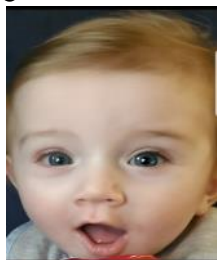
- Helps us in our weaknesses and helps us pray, Romans 8: 26-27.

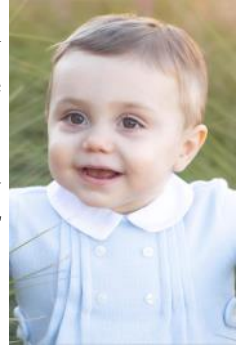

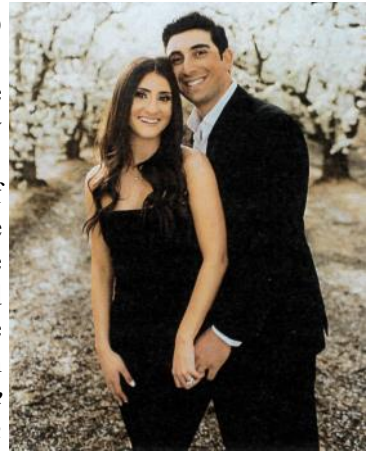


ENGAGEMENTS

The Fresno ANCHA (Armenian National Committee to Aid Homeless Armenians) Monument Committee has proposed plans to erect a monument in memory of its founders at Masis/Ararat Cemetery in Fresno. Graphic artist Vicken Massoyan has submitted his design, and the plan to move forward is now with the City of Fresno, the engineers, and the Masis/Ararat Cemetery Board. This monument will depict the images of: humanitarian and philanthropist George Mardikian, Attorney Suren Saroyan, and Brigadier General Haig Shekerjian. The efforts of these men were supported by the ARF (Armenian Revolutionary Federation), the ARS (Armenian Relief Society), the Holy Trinity Armenian Apostolic Church of Fresno as were all the Armenian Prelacy churches, and the Armenian American Citizens' League. All chapters of these organizations were fully engaged in this magnificent humanitarian effort to relocate the DPs (Displaced Persons) of post WWII.

This humanitarian effort began with some 3,000 DPs in a camp near Stuttgart, Germany and branched out to include Eastern Europe, the Middle East plus China and Egypt totaling approximately 25,000 - 30,000 lives reclaimed. 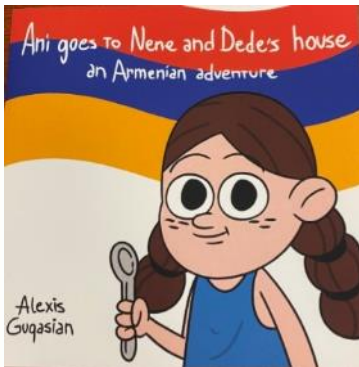
