Why Are We Hesitant To Confess Our Sins?

In his letter to the Hebrews, and while He was explaining about God's mercy and love towards humanity, Paul the Apostle wrote «Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need» (Heb. 4.16). He wrote these words to encourage those who stay away from God because of their feeling of guilt caused by the sins they have committed.

As human beings we often feel guilty because we know that whatever we did was a trespassing of a commandment or a law. However, the Apostle comes to remind us about the spiritual trespassing and the response that we get from our heavenly Father. He encourages us to overcome the feeling of guilt by approaching God's throne with confidence. We ought to have that confidence, especially when we know that God is a merciful and benevolent Father, who accepts us as His children and pours upon us his grace and mercy, in addition to his bountiful gifts.

We should all remember that God will accept us every time we repent for our sins, because He was the ultimate sacrifice who shed His blood to reconcile us with Himself. In other words, He was the only one who could erase our sins and make us worthy to become His children. So, knowing this important truth about our God, we do not have to feel guilty for our sins anymore, rather we should approach God's throne and ask for His mercy and grace.

Receiving God's mercy means receiving forgiveness for our sins, guidance for our steps, and hope when we have lost it while we were away from Him. Besides, finding His grace means finding the light while we are in the darkness, finding the love while we are surrounded by the spirit of hatred, and finding the right path after being astray from it. And who does not want to receive all these virtues after being separated from them?

Beloved faithful, let us keep these words of the Apostle in our minds and hearts, so it encourages us every time we fall. Let us have the courage to overcome the shameful feeling of guilt by approaching God's throne and asking for His forgiveness. Let us not forget about our nature, that we are not perfect, we will fall every time. However, the strength that will make us stand once again and continue our journey will be granted to us by God Himself.

In many ways, the pandemic has cast a shadow over the world. The collective trauma we have experienced has forever changed our lives. Facing uncertainty is a daily occurrence. It is in this context that we need to remind ourselves that Christ is the radiance of God’s glory. In John 8:12, Jesus proclaims, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” Instead of being so focused on our own circumstances, our priority should be to reflect daily on the light of the world, Jesus.

The Nicene Creed, which is the fundamental statement of faith of most Christian churches including the Armenian Church, establishes Jesus as the source of light in our lives:

And in one Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of God, begotten of God the Father, only begotten, that is of the substance of the Father. God from God, light from light, true God from true God, begotten and not made; of the same nature of the Father, by whom all things came into being in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible.

Hebrews 1:3 too reinforces the truth that Jesus “is the radiance of God’s glory” and “the exact representation of His being.” The words “God from God, light from light, true God from true God” must sustain us on a daily basis, no matter what we are facing. Theologian John Piper explains how we can do this, “Worship is a way of gladly reflecting back to God the radiance of His worth.” Find time daily to worship Jesus and to be sustained by His word; Psalms 95:6 reads, “Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker; for He is our God and we are the people of His pasture, the flock under His care.” Let us make a conscious effort to walk in the light of Jesus, casting our cares on Him, and worshipping God with all our hearts and minds.

Prayer for the Week – Thank You Heavenly Father for sustaining us through Your powerful word. We accept Your Son Jesus Christ as Lord and choose to walk in His light. Even though there are many difficulties in life, we know that we can find peace in worshipping You. Please watch over our families, granting us health and safety according to Your will. We pray these things in Jesus’ name. Amen!

Ignoring the Treasure

If you knew there was a priceless treasure on your property, what would you do? Excitedly hunt and hunt until you found it, right? You'd likely give up whatever you had to in order to get the tools and time you needed to find that treasure. Jonah's story, then, might sound strange, but it's all-too-often true.

You see, Jonah knew there was a treasure on his father's property. His father had even given him a treasure map so he could find it. Jonah was excited at first, but he easily gave up. He went through a phase where he got busy with playing games and having a good time, forgetting about the treasure. There came a day, though, when Jonah realized he really needed money. And he had good reason! Some friends were hurting and he wanted to help them. He began occasionally asking his father for more money...all the while failing to dig for the treasure his father had already told him would be his if he just searched for it. Interestingly enough, he'd go to other fields and dig there for treasure, hoping to find something. But the only thing he found was counterfeit currency. He kept tiring himself out for nothing, all the while ignoring the treasure map his father had given him.

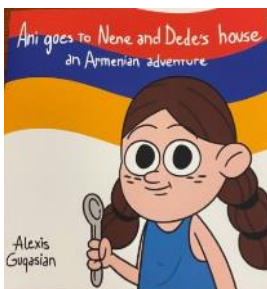

GET TO KNOW Sharon Boyajian-Paul Williams By Sarah Soghomonian



There's an open door policy at Sharon Williams' Kingsburg home. Someone is just about always coming or going.

"I see somebody from my family every day," Williams said, while sitting in her living room. "They come in and out."

Williams lives not far from where she grew up. She was born in 1943 at the old Fowler Hospital. Her parents were Andy Boyajian and Julia Nahigian-Boyajian.

Her childhood wasn't exactly storybook. Her parents split when she was young. Her mother was briefly married to Albert Paul. He adopted Sharon and growing up she went by the name Sharon Paul.

She spent a lot of time with her grandparents, Serma and Krikor Nahigian. They pretty much raised her. They lived on a vineyard off Conejo.

"It was interesting to grow up in Kingsburg because it was a Danish and Swedish town," Williams says. "There were just a few Armenians."

Williams attended Kingsburg schools and graduated from Kingsburg High in 1961.

"I had a pretty normal school life," she says. "I was very solitary. I read a lot."

Williams learned how to run an Armenian household from her grandparents. She'd cook with her grandma and learned how to make dolma and paklava from scratch.

"I'd eat the dough with butter on it," she says, with a laugh. "It was good."

On Sundays the family would load into the car and make the trek to Fresno to attend church at Holy Trinity. Sharon was baptized there. She attended Sunday School as a child and taught classes as a teen. She was involved in Young Legion, sang in the choir and took part in other youth activities.

"I've been studying the Bible since I was 12," she says. "I feel right into the Bible."

Williams credits her Armenian upbringing for making her stronger, despite personal struggles. She says the members of the church were like aunts and uncles to her.

"I always felt different," she says. "But I never felt abandoned."

After church Sharon and her family would gather at her great-uncle's house on O Street. She loved how people would come and go from the Old Armenian Town houses. That might be where her own open door policy stems from.

After graduating high school, Sharon moved to Fresno. She lived in the dorms while attending Fresno State and worked at Drug Fair in the Tower District.

On September 3, 1966 she married the love of her life, Warren Williams. The two first met when Sharon was 12 years old and spent summers swimming at Kingsburg High.





“I would stare at him at the swimming pool,” she says. “We started dating when I was 14.”

The pair had three children. Janet was born in 1967. Julianne in 1968. And Bill in 1971.

Warren’s work took the family away from Kingsburg. They spent many years living in Concord, where he worked as a funeral director. In the 1980s, Sharon returned to school and got her Master’s in Public Administration at Hayward.

She began working in early childhood education for Gospel Church in Concord and Concord Christian Schools.

The Williams briefly moved back to the Valley and Sharon had a flower shop in Riverdale before returning to the Bay Area. Then in 2000 the family moved back for good. They settled in Kingsburg and Sharon took a job with Valley Public Television before working with College of the Sequoias and directing a childcare center in Kingsburg. At the age of 62, Williams returned to school again. This time to become a Marriage and Family Therapist. She’s been with the Family Healing Center for 13 years.

The return to the Valley, also meant a return to Holy Trinity Armenian Apostolic Church. “Coming to church saved me,” Williams says, regarding the transition back to Kingsburg. “I sit in the very same place in church where my grandma sat. I think it’s faith that builds your resilience.”

Williams is a member of the Ladies’ Guild and had been teaching Bible study on Thursday mornings for 14 years. She also attends Armenian language classes offered by the church. Through these activities, she’s made a lot of “wonderful friends.” Williams has traveled to Armenia several times.

“I love it there,” she says, with a big smile. “I would live there if my family would move with me. When you touch the ground, you know where you came from.” And speaking of knowing where you came from, Williams is proud to say that she’s reconnected with her Boyajian family.

“That’s been a real positive in my life,” she says. Especially in the wake of her husband’s death. Warren passed away in 2019. “I miss his love and support,” she says. “I miss his laughter.” Williams gets by in part from the support of her family. Her children and five grandchildren all live in Kingsburg. And she gets her strength from God.

“The love of God was instilled in me,” she says. “I think God has a plan for the Armenians.”
