What Are the Origins of the Holy Muron?

Every single item in the church that is used for sanctifying or praising the Lord, has a Biblical origin. The Holy Muron or the Holy Oil also, being one of the important items has its Biblical origins.

Sanctifying something with (Holy) Oil was first mentioned in Genesis 28:18 when Jacob was fleeing from Esau, right after the dream he had in Bethel. However, In the book of Exodus and while God was telling Moses how to build the temple and how to prepare the priests, He also tells Moses how to make the Anointing Oil and what to use it for. God said "...Then use it to anoint the Tent of Meeting, the Ark of the Testimony, the table and all its articles, the lampstand and its accessories, the altar, of incense, the altar of burnt offering and all its utensils, and the basin with its stand. You Shall consecrate them so they will be most holy, and whatever touches them will be holy." (Exodus 30:22-29).

Then God continued and said "Anoint Aaron and his sons and consecrate them so they may serve me as priests. Say to the Israelites, 'This is to be my sacred anointing oil for the generations to come. Do not pour it on anyone else's body and do not make any other oil using the same formula. It is sacred, and you are to consider it sacred. Whoever makes perfume like it and puts it on anyone other than a priest must be cut off from their people.'" We read about the ordination of Aaron and his sons in the 8th chapter of the book of Leviticus. It is also worth mentioning that the Israelites used to anoint their kings and prophets too, and we can read about that in 1 Samuel 16:1-13, 1 King 19:16, and Psalms 105:15.

In the New Testament, the Holy Oil is not mentioned. However, the whole New Testament is all about the Anointed Messiah who came and sanctified all those who believe in Him through the Holy Spirit.

According to the tradition, the Holy Muron came to Armenia through St. Thaddeus, which was given to him by our Lord Jesus Christ to heal people. This oil was preserved until St. Gregory the Illuminator and King Dertad converted Armenia into Christian nation and when St. Gregory blessed the Holy Muron, he mixed that oil with the new oil. Therefore, the reason of mixing the old Muron with the new one is to keep the continuity and the blessing of the Lord in the church. Today's Holy Muron in the Armenian Apostolic Church is composed of olive oil and 40 aromas of flowers. In addition of the prayers, psalms and hymns we bless the Muron with the relic of St. Gregory the Illuminator and ask for the intercession of the Saint so that God blesses his people through the Holy Muron.

Եկեղեցոյ մէջ գործածուած իւրաքանչիւր առարկայ կամ նիւթ ունի Աստուածաշնչական ծագում: Սրբալոյս Միւռնը եւս, եկեղեցոյ կարեւորագոյն նիւթերէն մէկը ըլլալով, յայտնաբերուած է Հին Կտակարանի էջերուն մէջ եւ կոչուած՝ օծումի իւղ:

Օծումի առաջին արարքը կը գտնենք Ծննդոց գրքի 28րդ գլխուն 18րդ համարին մէջ, ուր Յակոբ Բեթելի մէջ ունեցած տեսիլքէն ետք, կ'առնէ այն քարը որուն վրայ իր գլուխը հանգչեցուցած էր, գայն իւղով կ'օծէ եւ որպէս արձան կը կանգնէ: Սակայն, երբ կարդանք Ելից գիրքը, եւ յատուկ ուշադրութիւն տրամադրենք գրքի վերջին 10 գլուխներուն, ուր Աստուած Մովսէսի կը պատուիրէ թէ ինչպէս պէտք է շինէ տաճարը, եւ անոր մէջ ծառայող քահանաները ինչպէս պէտք է պատրաստէ: Նոյն գլուխներուն մէջ, Տէրը նաեւ Մովսէսի կը թելադրէ թէ օծումի իւղը ինչպէս պէտք է պատրաստէ եւ ինչ բաներու օգտագործէ (Ելից. 30:22-33): Ահարոնի ու անոր որդիներուն՝ այսինքն քահանաներուն օծման մասին կը կարդանք Ղեւտացիներու գրքին 8րդ գլխուն մէջ: Նաեւ կ'արժէ նշել, թէ Իսրայէլացիները կ'օծէին իրենց թագաւորներն ու մարգարէները. այս մասին կրնանք կարդալ Ա. Թագաւորաց 16:1-13, Գ. Թագաւորաց 19:16 եւ Սաղմոս 105:15-ի մէջ:

Նոր Կտակարանի մէջ Սուրբ Իւղի մասին ռեւէ յիշատակութիւն չկայ, սակայն Նոր Կտակարանը ամբողջութեամբ կը խօսի Օծեալ Մեսիային երկրաւոր առաքելութեան մասին, եւ կը մատնանշէ, թէ բոլոր անոնք որոնք իրեն կը հաւատան Սուրբ Հոգիով կը սրբագործուին:

Աւանդութեան համաձայն, Սրբալոյս Միւռնը Հայաստան աշխարհի հասած է Ս. Թադէոս Առաքեալի միջոցաւ, որուն յանձնուած էր մեր Տիրոջ՝ Յիսուս Քրիստոսի կողմէ: Այս իւղը պահուած էր մինչեւ Ս. Գրիգոր Լուսաւորիչի օրերը: Երբ Ս. Գրիգոր եւ Տրդատ թագաւոր Հայաստանը պետականօրէն Քրիստոնէութեան կը դարձնեն, Սուրբ Լուսաւորիչը կը կատարէ առաջին Միւռնօրհնէքը, եւ Սուրբ Թադէոս Առաքեալի բերած իւղը կը խառնէ սրբալոյս միւռնին: Կ'արժէ յիշել թէ այսօրուան Հայ Առաքելական Եկեղեցոյ մէջ օգտագործուող Ս. Միւռնը կը բաղկանայ 40 տեսակ ծաղիկներու հիւթերէ: Նաեւ, Սրբալոյս Միւռնի օրհնութեան արարողութեան ընթացքին, Սուրբ Միւռնը աղօթքներու, սաղմոսներու եւ Աստուածաշնչական ընթերցումներու հետ միասին կ'օրհնուի Ս. Գրիգոր Լուսաւորիչի աջով եւս, եւ կը խնդրուի սուրբին բարեխօսութիւնը:

A Father's Promise

Ten years ago (1989), an 8.2 earthquake almost flattened Armenia, killing over 30,000 people in less than four minutes. It's hard to imagine the anguish, the pain, and the suffering that began in those four brief minutes of time -- people's worlds were shaken and lives crushed. In spite of the devastation, such tragedies often bring out the best in people -- at least it provides a window to peak at the contents of each heart. Let me show you the loving heart of one father.

In the midst of chaos and destruction, he rushed to his son's school. But instead of a school, he found a shapeless heap of rubble. Imagine what went through his mind. What would have gone through your mind? Perhaps, shock would have crippled you as it did the other parents who were walking around dazed, clutching at their hearts and calling out their child's name. But in the case of this father, the sight of rubble and ruin only made him spring into action. He ran to the back corner of the building where his son's classroom used to be and began to dig. Why? What real hope did he have? What were the chances that his son could have survived such destruction? All he knew was that he had made a promise to always be there for his son. It was this promise that gave strength to his body and motivated him mentally.

As he began to dig, well-meaning parents tried to pull him out of the rubble saying: "It's too late!" "They're dead!" "You can't help!" "Go home!" "There's nothing you can do!" The fire chief tried to pull him off the rubble by saying, "Fires and explosions are happening everywhere. You're in danger. Go home!" Finally, the police came and said, "You're angry and distraught, but it's over. Go home." But this father had made a promise, and he was going to keep it!

The love this father had in his heart for his son kept him digging for 8... 12... 24... 36 hours. Then, in the 38th hour, he pulled back a boulder and heard his son's voice crying for help. Immediately, he screamed, "ARMAND!" Back came the words, "Dad!?! I told them! I told the other kids that if you were still alive, you'd save me! You promised me, you said you'd always be there for me! You did it, dad!

A determined father, a promise kept, and a stone rolled away to reveal life and give freedom. The story of Armand's dad reminds us of the events of that first Easter when our Heavenly Father kept a greater promise by rolling away a much more significant stone. With the rolling away of that stone, came eternal life, and true lasting freedom in Christ! And you know what? Our Heavenly Father is still in the business of rolling away stones.

What are the stones in your life? It doesn't matter how big or small they may be, our Father is looking for you right now. He's looking through the rubble and the ruin of lives not lived for Him, and He wants to roll away your stone of despair, your rock of remorse, your bolder of bondage. May you remember, or perhaps even discover for the first time, that our God has made the greatest promises ever made, and He is abundantly able to keep them all, just as He kept that very special promise to His own Son some two thousand years ago.

Message: But the one whom God raised from the dead did not see decay. Therefore, my brothers, I want you to know that through Jesus the forgiveness of sins is proclaimed to you. Acts 13:37-38
