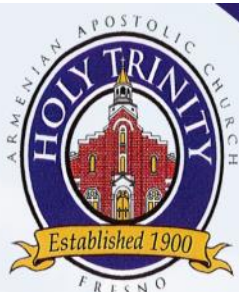

News from the Holy See of Cilicia

His Holiness Aram I arrived in Aleppo for a one-day pontifical visit on Thursday, February 16, 2023. The Catholicos was received at the entrance of the Church of the Holy Mother of God by the Prelate of Aleppo, the Diocesan Council, the heads of the community, and the faithful.



In his pontifical address during the Divine Liturgy, His Holiness expressed his solidarity with the people and exhorted the community to remain strong in their faith and cling to the church and to its affiliated structures. Following the Divine Liturgy, His Holiness received the faithful at the atrium of the church, where he conveyed his speech and gave them his blessings.

During his solidarity one-day pontifical trip to Aleppo, His Holiness Aram I visited various neighborhoods affected by the earthquake, witnessed the damages, and prayed for the repose of the souls of the victims. Subsequently, he convened with the representatives of the community organizations and institutions, and learned about their concerns and challenges, and the work they've accomplished thus far. Finally, His Holiness Aram I paid condolence visits to the governor of Aleppo and the party leader.



Western Prelacy News

In light of the disastrous earthquake that hit the Middle East, H.G. Bishop Torkom Donoyan, Prelate, appealed for immediate assistance by all the parishes of the Western Prelacy, which resulted in the accumulation of \$100,000 dollars.

On the occasion of the Feast of Sts. Ghevontians, the clergy of the Western Prelacy held their annual clergy conference at St. Mary's Armenian Church in Glendale. Having turned their prayer into action, handed over their financial support to the Prelate, as a support for the immediate assistance for needs of the Syrian Armenians in general and the Armenians in Aleppo in particular.

Bishop Donoyan highly commended the efforts of the clergy and boards of trustees, who not only show wholehearted support to the programs of the Western Prelacy, but also make every effort to lend a helping hand to our brothers and sisters in Armenian and the Diaspora, with the main goal of alleviating the pain and suffering, based on Armenian-Christian principals, to support them in their most difficult days.

An Altruistic Angel

A very poor girl was working as a nurse in a private hospital. A patient admitted to the hospital suddenly became seriously ill and had to be shifted to a major hospital to save his life. The administrator of the hospital insisted that the patient could be discharged only after he had paid his dues completely. The amount in the bill was too big for the poor family. They requested that they may be allowed some time to raise the amount as they were very poor and the patient was critically ill, but the administrator was adamant. The patient's wife was in tears.

The nurse, who had just arrived for duty, learned the gravity of the situation and made a personal plea to the administrator, but the management wanted the money immediately and was not ready to show any mercy. She quickly removed her golden bangle and deposited it in the cash counter and asked to discharge the patient without any delay. The critically ill patient was then shifted to the major hospital and his life was saved. The bangle was her only valuable possession, but she was ready to donate it to save a poor patient.

The bold and timely action of the loving nurse caught the attention of the doctor on duty. He was immensely impressed by her charity. He was a very rich man but was reluctant to act when the patient's life was in danger. He was enlightened by her act of affection. He told his friend, Dr. D. John, "Today I saw Jesus. He is a girl!"

The wealthy doctor went home and told his parents about his desire to marry the nurse. His loving parents accepted the proposal and held discussions with the nurse and her parents. Their wedding was celebrated in the presence of their friends and relatives.

Jesus taught, "My commandment is this: love one another, just as I love you. The greatest love a person can have for his friends is to give his life for them" {John 15:12-13}. St. John reminds us, "My children, our love should not be just words and talk; it must be true love, which shows itself in action" {1 John 3:18}.

Love is the language that Jesus taught his disciples as the universal medium for preaching the gospel. Love can be heard by the deaf, seen by the blind and felt even by the new-born and the mentally retarded.

DEDICATION DAY

On Sunday, April 16, 2023, the Fresno ANCHA Monument Committee will memorialize the trio of Armenian heroes: George Mardikian, Suren Saroyan and Brigadier General Haig Shekerjian. These men dedicated their lives to the service of humanity by finding homes for the homeless post WWII from Germany and later from the Balkan states and Middle East mostly to the USA.

Organizations quickly mobilized and provided assistance to ANCHA. At the forefront was the Armenian Relief Society. Immediately after, the Prelacy churches followed with parishioners housing several families. Acculturation was begun by local Armenian American Citizens League members once families settled in.

Prior to ANCHA, the Armenian Revolutionary Federation members were conferring with Hitler to free Armenian prisoners of war. All in all, over 25,000 Armenian lives were saved. It is fitting and proper that we share our history for generations to come.

We will dedicate this ANCHA Monument to their memory.

The monument ceremony will follow church services under the auspices of Bishop Torkom Donoyan and Very Rev. Fr. Ashod Khachadourian. The Homenetmen Scouts will lead off the ceremony followed by the dedication and then reception to follow hosted by our very own Patty Torosian.
