The Feast of Transfiguration VARTAVAR

The Feast of Transfiguration holds a central place in the Armenian Apostolic Church due to its connection to a significant event in the life of Jesus Christ (Matthew 17:1-13, Mark 9:2-13, Luke 9:28-36). This feast was established in the Armenian Church after Saint Gregory the Illuminator emerged from imprisonment to baptize King Tiridates III, marking Armenia as the first Christian nation.

Spreading a new faith across an entire country posed challenges, particularly in a culture deeply rooted in belief in various gods and goddesses. Saint Gregory tackled this challenge by replacing pagan festivals with Christian ones. For instance, he substituted the feast of the fire god with the presentation of Jesus Christ at the temple, and he transformed the Armenian New Year celebration (Navasart) on August 11th into the Feast of Transfiguration, later integrating it with the Feast of the Assumption of the Holy Virgin.

As Saint Gregory successfully converted the majority of Armenians to Christianity, he reimagined the Feast of Navasart as the Feast of Transfiguration, symbolizing a renewal for the Armenian people. During this feast, traditions such as water play and releasing pigeons evoked parallels with the story of Noah's ark, prompting reflection among church leaders.

In 551 AD, Catholicos Movses II Yeghivartetsi adjusted the Armenian calendar, moving the Feast of Transfiguration to the seventh week after the Ascension to align it with the Feast of the Assumption, celebrated in the same month.

Reflecting on the spiritual meanings behind these traditions, playing with water may signify purification from sin, spiritual refreshment, or rejoicing in the spiritual nourishment of life-giving water. Releasing pigeons might symbolize freeing souls from the bonds of sin, offering prayers to God, or advocating for peace and love among all people.

In conclusion, let us cherish and uphold our traditions, as many are rooted in Biblical truths that guide our faith and community.
