DID YOU KNOW?

History of the Holy Trinity Church Organizations

In 1892, the first Armenian structure in Fresno was erected on Monterey and "F" street to serve as a library and cultural center. The purpose was to help in the educational, social and moral development of Armenian refugees. The library had approximately 400 books and membership was 25 cents monthly for anyone of age 15 and older. Social events, lectures and other celebrations were held in the cultural center's hall. In 1895, the Library Association participated in the July 4th parade with a float in the name of Armenia.

In 1900, Holy Trinity Church's wooden structure was built just adjacent to the library and cultural center. Because of the denominational split in the community, the library was unable to pay the balance of the mortgage. As a result, Holy Trinity Church purchased the library, with its nearly 1,000 books, and cultural center. In 1913, a fire destroyed Holy Trinity Church along with the library and cultural center. Due to the fire, much information about our church's history and other records are missing.

In July 1914, the Ladies' Aid was formed with the purpose of aiding the church financially and morally, supporting the Holy Trinity Church Saturday Armenian School, assisting the needy, destitute and sick, and counseling bereaved families. By November, the initial 16 members rose to 68 members.

In 1929, the Young Legion was formed. It served the church in various ways, the library being one of them. In 1971, the Young Legion was reorganized and renamed Hye Trinity Youth.

In 1949, a group of young mothers, realizing the need for an organization to sponsor and support the Sunday School, formed the Trinity Guild. With approximately 100 members, it became the most active organization in the church.

Also in 1949, a group of young men, realizing that the task of administration of the Church could someday fall upon their shoulders, formed the Holy Trinity Men's Society.

The Rose That Wanted to Be a Lily

Once upon a time, there was a beautiful garden. But one day, Petal noticed another flower that grew in the shade. Why do I have to endure all this heat while that flower doesn't? she wondered. Petal didn't understand that different flowers need different amounts of sunlight to grow, but the gardener knew all that. Rather than trusting him, though, Petal managed to pull up her roots and move herself to a different part of the garden where she could hide in the shade too. Ah, this is nice! she thought. Yet soon she began wilting, and her leaves turned yellow. She wasn't designed for the shade. The gardener lovingly picked her up and put her back in a sunny spot.

"Ah, my dear Petal," he said as he moved her. "I need you to bloom where I put you. Won't you trust me? I know just the pruning and conditions each of my plants need." "Jesus said to him, "If it is my will that he remain until I come, what is that to you? You follow me!" John 21:22.

Another time Petal noticed a small lily growing near her. Such beautiful flowers that lily has, she thought to herself. I wish my petals looked more like hers. 
